This is a report on the visit to Komipharm International Australia Site 11 Monterey Rd, Dandenong South, Victoria by Member of Dandenong Gabrielle Williams.

Also attending was Director Heewon Seo of Komipharm International Australia, Andrew Han Director of Bio And Gene, Shelly Freeman from Freeman Consultancy, Dr Antonio (Tony) Rajic Senior Investment Manager and Gerry Roe Program Manager both representing the State Government Department of Economic Development

The member announced Komipharm International Australia would receive a grant to help the company expand and create a new global headquarters and research and development hub in Dandenong South.

The project was noted as the largest pharmaceutical tablet making facilities to be built in Dandenong as part of the Andrews Labor Government's investment into jobs and manufacturing.

We took her on the tour through the factory and we explained where the API and cleanrooms would be constructed. She was very impressed of the size of the facility.

We then showed her the back of the factory where we described the future that a building for Institute for R & D and Commercialisation would be developed. The institute would provide a facility of excellence in collaboration with Hospitals, Medical Biotech and all the Education

Institutions to develop and better existing KOMINOX products and also allow new technologies to be developed to better the health and wellbeing of patients.

We also concluded that Komipharm International Australia will become the Global Platform to support and export of API and finished and packed tablets to the Global Market.

Refreshments sandwiches snacks and soda drinks were served in the board room and further discussions and interaction took place. The cost of entertainment was \$223.65.

Ms Gabrielle Williams MP offered assistance to Komipharm where we are having any difficulties with services like the electricity and municipality.

They would also assist in the acceleration of the planning approval process.

One of the largest pharmaceutical tablet making facilities in the world will be built in Dandenong South.

Dandenong MP Gabrielle Williams visited Komipharm International Australia on Thursday 15 December to announce a State Government grant to help the company expand.

The Local Industry Fund for Transition (LIFT) cash will allow Komipharm to create a new global headquarters and research and development hub in Monterey Road.

The company will hire 40 new workers, including 10 people who lost their jobs in the automotive industry.

Komipharm will also expand its global sales footprint through better access to markets in North America and Western Europe.

The business was among 12 to share in \$6.47 million in LIFT grants announced this month. The commercial-in-confidence grants are part of the Towards Future Industries: Victoria's Automotive Transition Plan designed to fund business expansions to create new jobs for retrenched automotive workers.

"While the closure of auto manufacturing has presented significant challenges for our region, we are working with businesses to find expansion opportunities and create jobs so that automotive workers can transition into new roles," Ms Williams said.

"Supporting Komipharm means we are helping a local manufacturer expand their market, which creates long-term job opportunities."
